Cub Scout Packs may go camping at any of the facilities listed on this chart provided they have a leader who has completed BALOO training and will attend the camping trip. Effective January 1, 2003, a tour permit will only be issued if these two requirements are met. If you wish to camp at a location or facility not listed here, you must submit a written request to the Director of Camping at least 90 days in advance of the desired trip date.
